11 year-old Nancy is from a single-parent home. Her mother struggles to raise her on the income she is receiving and sometimes moves from place to place as rent becomes too expensive. Nancy often starts the day without breakfast and is acutely aware that there is hardly any extra for anything beyond the basic necessities. She also struggles with her daily work and relies on support given at the student care centre for questions she may have while doing her homework or revision. Moving from place to place also gives her the feeling of insecurity as she has not had a stable home.*

If only the student care centre had a bus that could send me home! <i>Thank you. I can now attend the after-school student care with the specially arranged bus transport!</i></p>

I also have no shoes to go out and play in other than my school shoes. I would really like a pair of shoes and perhaps 1 or 2 sets of clothes which fit me and make me look neat and smart. <i>Thank you. This will be my first brand new pair of shoes which I can run and play in. I also have clothes just my size.</i></p>	<p>Learning Aids</p> <p>S\$5000 I do not hear very well. I do not speak very clearly. I also cannot see what my teacher has written on the board or when she uses the PowerPoint to teach me in class. I think I need a new set of hearing aids and a pair of glasses. I also need a new 'voice' so that others can understand me when I communicate. <i>Thank you. I can now hear, speak and see clearly. The learning aids are so helpful! This will help me to achieve my goal of doing the best I can when I am learning.</i></p>
<p>Enrichment</p> <p>S\$300 My parents are odd job workers and cannot afford the little extra for programmes and activities that are organised for me. I wish I could participate in them too so that I can learn how to be a better person to care and help others when I grow up. <i>Thank you.
